In 2015 Family Promise of Summit County served 38 families made up of 76 children and 50 adults. This is a 15% increase over 2014. The average length of stay was 31 days. There were 441 requests for shelter. 84% of our families moved into permanent housing, 7% moved in with family or friends, 7% exited the program due to guideline violations, and 1% are unknown. Many thanks to all of our faithful volunteers who help make this program possible.
